

The Rotary Club of Greater Clark County 2018 Bob Kaleta/Randy Salisbury Music Scholarship Application



Each year the Rotary Club of Greater Clark County selects *one* high school senior to receive a Music Studies scholarship in the amount of \$3000.00. The scholarship must be applied to tuition and fees at a post-secondary institution.

Requirements:

Applicant must:

- Be a 2018 graduate of Evergreen, Henrietta Lacks, Heritage, Mountain View, Union or Ridgefield High School;
- Complete and submit the two-page application form attached;
- Submit an essay discussing life goals (educational, career, and service) as they relate to the Rotary motto *Service Above Self*. Applicants should reflect on past accomplishments, future attainments, and how work *in the field of music* will impact the world today and in the future. (1000 word limit)

Application Deadline:

Monday **March 12, 2018**. The completed application must be submitted. Interviews:

Semi-finalists will be notified by Monday **April 16, 2018**. Interviews will be held on Monday **April 23, 2018**.

Evaluation Criteria:

Equal weight will be given to the application responses and the essay. The application should reflect high scholarship, moral character, and *strong* involvement in school and community activities. In addition to addressing the essay prompt, the essay will be evaluated on style, originality, and critical thinking.

Award Schedule:

Notification of the scholarship recipients will be made by Wednesday April 25, 2018. The scholarship recipient and a family member of his or her family will be invited to attend the **Thursday May 3rd,2018** noon meeting of The Rotary Club of Greater Clark County.
