

## **The Rotary Club of Greater Clark County General Studies 2024 Scholarship Application**

Each year the Rotary Club of Greater Clark County selects **Two** high school seniors to receive a General Studies scholarship in the amount of \$2000.00. The scholarship must be applied to tuition and fees at a post-secondary institution or accredited vocational program.

### Requirements:

#### Applicant must:

- Be a 2024 graduate of Evergreen, Henrietta Lacks, Heritage, Mountain View, Union High Schools, or receive a 2024 certificate of completion from Cascadia Tech Academy.
- Complete and submit the two-page application form attached.
- Submit an essay discussing Rotary's motto **Service Above Self** and what it means to you. Applicants should reflect on past accomplishments, future attainments, and how their career goals will impact the world today and in the future. (1000-word limit)

### Application Deadline:

Monday **April 1st, 2024**. The completed application must be submitted.

### Interviews:

Semi-finalists will be notified by Monday **April 19<sup>th</sup>**,. Interviews will be held on Thursday **April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024**.

### Evaluation Criteria:

Equal weight will be given to the application responses and the essay. The application should reflect high scholarship, moral character, and *strong* involvement in school and community activities. In addition, the essay will be evaluated on style, originality, creativity, and critical thinking.

### Award Schedule:

Notification of the scholarship recipients will be made by Friday **April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024**. The scholarship recipient and a family member of his or her family will be invited to attend the **Thursday May 16<sup>th</sup>**, noon meeting of The Rotary Club of Greater Clark County at Cascadia Tech Academy.

\*Interviews and Club meetings will be evaluated for in-person or electronic meeting platforms as we get closer to these deadlines.

Briefly *describe* the three most significant high school activities in which you have participated.

Focusing on Rotary motto “service above self,” briefly *describe* the three most significant community service (*non-school related*) activities in which you have participated.
